Temporary Alcohol-Free Areas – New Year Period and Other Identified Events 2020-2021

This letter is to request temporary alcohol-free areas over the New Year period in addition to the permanent and New Year alcohol-free areas as defined in the Tauranga City Council Alcohol Control Bylaw 2018.

The temporary alcohol-free areas implemented in previous years have contributed to enhanced Police operations and a safer environment for the community during the New Year period. Therefore, NZ Police request the below temporary alcohol-free areas:

- Fergusson Park including Tilby Drive from the intersection of Tainui Street and Waratah Street (all inclusive) in Matua from 10am, 31 December 2020 to 6am, 1 January 2021, to support NZ Police operations at Council's New Year's Eve community event at the site.
- Gordon Spratt Reserve and Alice Way (all inclusive), and Parton Road (between Tara Road and Papamoa Beach Road) in Papamoa from 10am, 31 December 2020 to 6am, 4 January 2021, to support NZ Police operations at Council's New Year's Eve community event and the Bay Dreams pick up/drop off location on 3 January 2021 at the site.
- Tauranga Racecourse Reserve in Tauranga South from 10am, 31 December 2020 to 6am, 1 January 2021, to support NZ Police operations at Council's New Year's Eve community event at the site.
- The immediate surrounds of Trustpower Baypark Arena and Stadium from 10am 1 January 2021 to 6am 4 January 2021 to support NZ Police operations in response to the Bay Dreams Camping, Pre-Party and Music Festival being held at Trustpower Baypark Arena and Stadium on 2 and 3 January 2021.
- The Bay Dreams pick up/drop off location at Windermere Drive from 10am 3 January 2021 to 6am 4 January 2021 to support NZ Police operations in response to the Bay Dreams Music Festival being held at Trustpower Baypark Arena and Stadium on 3 January 2021.
- Soper Reserve and Newton Street (between Hull Road and Hewletts Road) from 10am 8 December 2020 to 6am 12 January 2021, from 10am 27 February 2021 to 6am, 28 February 2021 and from 10am, 6 March 2021 to 6am, 7 March 2021 to support NZ Police operations in response to the planned events being held at Soper Reserve.
