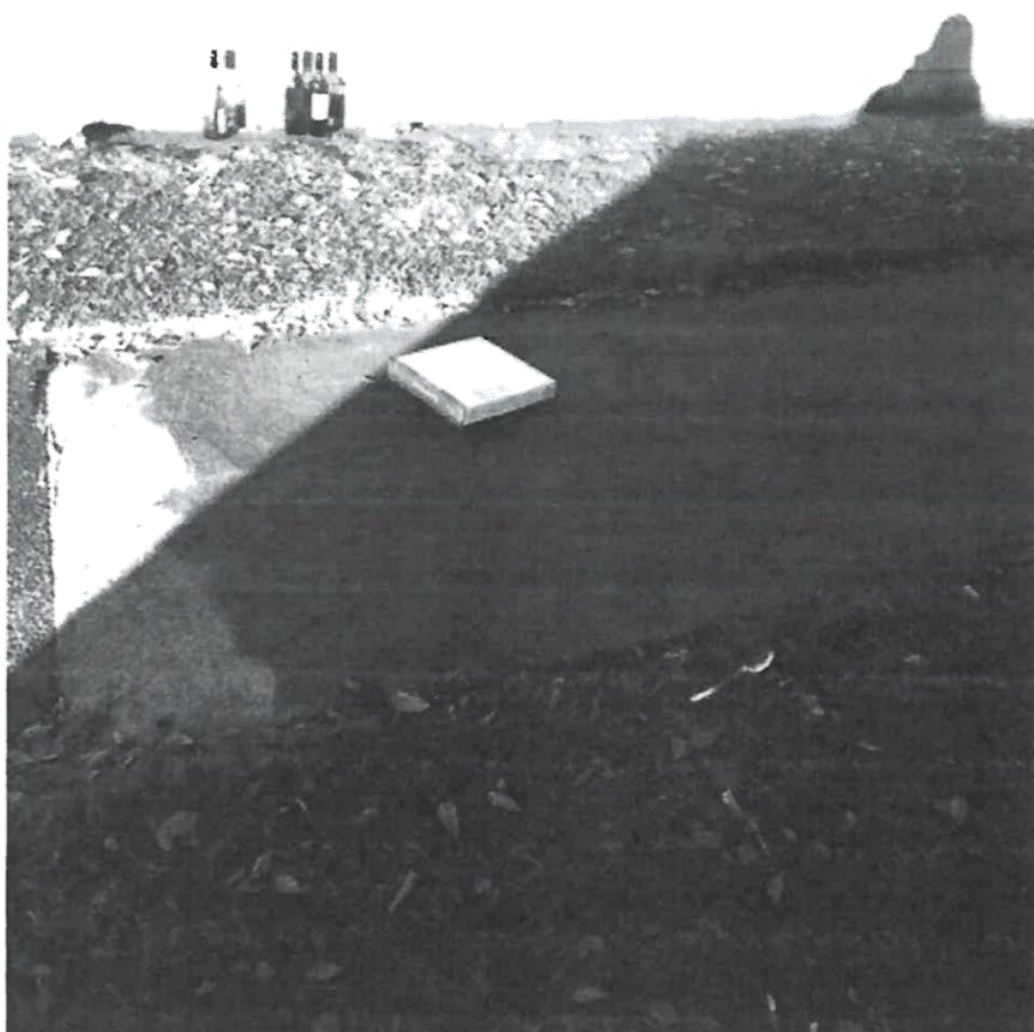

- 1) They sleep across the path as well as on the grass verges. They are drinking every day for most of the day. They leave their rubbish behind as well as clothes, they have been heard shouting from one of our neighbours, they spit, swear and on occasions have had loud music playing. It brings down the area and people we know who don't even live in this Road are disgusted by it.
- 2) Thursday 8th April I called the Police as someone was trying to break into the empty house next door. I heard some one say the fucking latch, the fucking latch Jamal. The Police arrived and they called me from a mobile 021 1913886 at 3.21p.m. They said they had Jamal and asked me if I had actually seen the people, which I didn't and I wasn't going to go onto the property to see.
- 3) 22nd April I was away and my husband was at home and a woman came onto our property and took some water from our outside tap. My husband knows what she looks like. We reported it on line and the Police called my husband. The Police were really helpful and said if they do it again we should try and get photos and call 111 immediately.
- 4) Friday 23rd April a lady was crossing the road as she came round the corner from Cameron Road onto 12th Avenue and nearly got ran over by a car. My husband asked if she was ok and she said 'I won't walk by them, pointing to the homeless people'. She said she always crosses the Road. This is the opinion of most of the old people in our Road. A lot of the people we spoke to had not got any faith in the Council or police to do anything, although they did sign the petition. We would like an alcohol ban on our street and neighbouring streets.
- 5) Saturday 1st May – one of them has moved nearer to the houses (outside Chorus) with what looks like a tent.
- 6) We have a lot of old people in our Road and it is frightening for them. I am in the process of setting up a neighborhood support through Bruce banks which everyone is happy with. A lot of people, although I went round during the day wouldn't open their door fully at first.
- 7) Tuesday 4th May – Out there before 8a.m. drinking 1 in a tent and three of them on the wall. 10.48a.m. They have now moved outside Chorus which is nearer to our homes I have emailed Toni Vazey from the By Laws Dept. at the Council at 11a.m. 2p.m. Rang 105 to report them being very loud and messing about on the pavement, all of them very drunk.
- 8) I am scared of going out incase they come onto our property.. I don't feel safe indoors on my own and I don't feel safe leaving the home empty. No body should have to live like this.
