Whether it is Government or hapū Housing the need is the same...


- > Every week of every month of every year, housing is a priority.
- > Government changes, Policy changes, less funding in the priority space.

Ngāti Kahu Te Pura Trust Papakainga

- After our first build with our Papakainga we are now looking at a 2-year plan. Our original concept drawings submitted to Council shows up to 53 sections / homes over a period of 25 years.
- We have built 12 homes and going forward, our 2-year plan gives us scope for another 12 to be built.
- > We are looking at working relationships to achieve this. Likewise funding relationships.
- > House planning and models are an important requirement as this build could be a mix of Rental, Home ownership, and Long-term Lease
- ➤ We would love Tangata Whenua to be part of the build. Our model is linking into Trade Trainees.

It's all about relationships and trust.

It's not about having our hand out, we need to find a way forward where both parties contribute.



Stage 1: 12 Rental Homes <u>Completed</u> 2016

- 6 x 4 Bedroom and 6 x 2 Bedroom
- Ministry of Housing funded Infrastructure
- All services connected to TCC infrastructure.

Stage 2: Assistance Required for Ngati Kahu (12 homes of future 39 home development)

Rationale for Assistance

- Māori land is generally not sold or profited from like conventional developments.
- Iwi and hapū do not generate revenue from the sale of sections to cover initial development costs like conventional developments.
- In some cases, council infrastructure is either insufficient or at full capacity to support the intended level of development.


